Bird-wise, we had a really great walk. We saw some special birds, including a Nashville Warbler and a couple of Black-throated Gray Warblers. And Chip spotted a Cooper's Hawk on the nest on Arden. Most all got to see it, but it was pretty well hidden in the nest. We got 27 species in total, well-above the predicted 21.9. We only needed 2 more to tie the record for a week 14. But, not half-bad.
