We observed 20 species, which was well short of the predicted 25.7. And we did not see a Yellow-rumped Warbler.

It was listed as 100% probable and next week is 75% probable, followed by 25% at week 17, and 0% at week 18. So, a little early for their departure. It was a bit warm and that may have decreased the overall numbers

of species. So, a sub-par walk, which is bound to happen. On the positive side, Chris and Viveca each saved a turtle in what I used to call

Millikan pond. Not sure what it is called now. Good for them!
