So, no Yellow-rumped Warblers, just as I expected. They arrive in week 40 and leave in week 16, and they left right on cue. Good for them. We observed 25 species, including three zero-probables, so good for us. We puzzled over a flock of dark shore/water birds and I'm putting them down as Cormorant, sp., as they were different from the other Shore/water bird I saw, which was white. Anyway, it was a good walk with 25 species observed, 1.3 birds above my prediction and 5 above the median. The max for week 17 is 29; we didn't approach that number.
