And we got a big surprise at the end: 2 Canada Geese out on the lawn near the flag pole. Along with the Mallard in the wrong pool of water. We added Warbler, species, despite having seen an Orange-crowned Warbler, since the species was either a Wilson's or a Yellow. We had another tough Flycatcher sighting, so went with Species on that. All in all, very good walk.
