We did well. We recorded 19 species when the predicted was 16.6. And, we did see a partial bird over on Arden Road at the first stop. Lots of colorful Parrot feathers on the ground. We suspect a Cooper's Hawk dined on one, as that was the area where a pair recently hatched out three little hawks.

Not much else to say, except Mickey was back, despite having been penalized 5 yards last week for a lack of a Mourning Dove. We got 4 Mourning Doves this week, so no Mourning Dove penalty was assessed this week and I pardoned Mickey to boot. However, I should have assessed someone a Band-tailed Pigeon penalty, as that bird was 86% probable, yet no one saw one.

The record for next week is 20 and we got 19 this week, so watch out! I feel a record walk coming on.
